

<u>Queen's Royal - Friday Night</u>

Who's Eligible

Women Only event – Drivers & Passengers all must be licenced to compete

(Approval from Speedway Sedan Australia has been received to run these two classes together, in the same heats at this special one off event). **SSA Street Stocks and SSA Production Sedans ONLY.**

This event will follow the Top Stars / New Stars concept used in Junior Sedans to allow our inexperienced women competitors to race among themselves / off the back of the heats together if there isn't enough "New star" to have a heat by themselves.

Top Star entrants are defined by the following:

- # The competitor is a regular racer in their respective divisions
- # The competitor has raced in regular competition even if its only been a race or two
- # The competitor has competed in more than 2 Queens Royal events (this means any New Star that has raced at least twice in new stars will be put into Top Stars)
- # The competitor holds an Annual Speedway Australia licence
- # If you have been a New Star & finished on the podium at least twice you will be competing in Top Stars

New Star entrants are defined by the following:

- # The competitor has never raced or not competed as a competitor in regular competition at all or on a regular basis
- # The competitor has not competed at a Queens Royal on a regular basis

The decision of whether the competitor is a Top Star or a New Star is made by the South Burnett Speedway Club in consultation with Speedway Sedans Queensland. This decision is final.
